

Venezuela: Facts

- Northern tip of South-America
- Language: Spanish
- Per Capita Income: US\$ 5M
- 27 MM Inhabitants
- 50 M Physicians
- 8 Medical schools
- 49 Universities
- 7 M Medical students
- 60 Bio-Medical periodicals
- 640 M Internet subscriptions
- Average monthly physicians income: US\$ 450.00



Medical Editors Association of Venezuela –ASEREME-

- An independent “virtual” group, founded 1975
- Pioneer group in Latin-America
- First inspirations: ICMJE, Robert Day’s Book, BMJ (our most continuous source)
- 60 journals, most of them “not-academic” (Scientific Societies)
- Activities: monthly board meetings, annual editors meetings, seminars, conferences, workshops, editorial assessment
- Relations:
 - National: health and investigation authorities, academic,
 - International: BIREME, WAME, CSE, COPE, BMJ (Alex Williamson), The Lancet (Sabine Kleinert), EASE (Elise Langdon-Neuner)

Issues I/II

- **Authors:**
 - Unaware of ethical rules
 - Redundant publication
 - Authorship criteria
 - Citation and reference failures
 - Plagiarism
 - Lack of statistical treatment
 - Seldom translation into English
- **Editors**
 - Indexing failures
 - Redundant publication in the same journal
 - Punctuality and periodicity failures
 - Financial difficulties
 - Visibility: libraries, data bases, distribution
 - Web page and e-mail address failures.
 - Electronic format


